## Here's what a typical chess class involves:

- Students will meet at the picnic tables by the office until class starts at 3:00 pm, class ends at 4:00 pm every Tuesday in room 32.
- Children are first trained in tactics and the strategy behind their use.
- They then solve puzzles of appropriate difficulty based on the day's lesson.
- All students who are well prepared will then take place in a club-wide tournament game.

All our students become well versed in chess openings, tactics, and strategy, as well as the importance of proper decorum of the tournament hall. It is highly suggested that all students have access to a tournament chess set at home for study, and all of our advanced students are required to compete in at least 3 USCF rated chess tournaments as well as the State Championships near the end of the school year.
